Our auction winner "Principal for the Day", Lindsay Scarola, has granted an Out of Uniform day to the entire school, this Friday June 2nd. Please adhere to the Uniform code for Casual Dress - Out of Uniform days:

"On days when students are permitted to dress casually, tennis shoes may be worn. All clothing must be worn modestly. All casual pants must be worn at the waist. No bare midriffs, low-cut tops, or excessively tight or revealing jeans or tops are permitted. Shorts and skorts are permitted on casual dress day only during the time when the summer uniform is allowed to be worn. Shirts must be appropriate for school. (ex. No reference to bands, etc.) No spaghetti strap tops are allowed. No leggings may be worn as pants. Leggings may only be worn under dresses or skirts that are knee length. If a student is improperly dressed on any out of uniform day, they will be given alternate clothing to wear or their parents will be called to take them home or bring a change of clothes."
