These words of Christ from the Cross are worth our time in meditation, especially during this season of Lent. Forgiveness is so hard! The Lord was cursed, spit upon. falsely accused, condemned unjustly, taunted. He had every right to defend Himself and to show the people a thing or two. And yet, "Like a lamb led to the slaughter, He opened not His mouth" (Is. 53:7). How often do we seek or desire revenge upon those who have wronged us? How often do we seek to defend ourselves when we are wrongly accused or judged? This is not what the Lord desires for us. He, Himself, left us an example. We are, rather, to pray for those who persecute us or do us harm in any way: physically, emotionally, spiritually, or simply by the words of their mouth. As South African psychologist Pumla Gobodo-Madikizela stated in her book whose main theme is forgiveness, "Forgiveness does not overlook the deed: it rises above it." May we, too, like Christ, be given the grace to rise above the wrongs done to us and know deep peace through the power of forgiveness.
