PARENTS OF 7[™] GRADE STUDENTS

During these early teenage years, children are frequently assessed by their physicians for any sign and symptoms of scoliosis. If your child has not had a physical that included this assessment or you have a concern about scoliosis and your child, the attached reference is very useful in determining if your child is showing any possible signs or symptoms of scoliosis.
