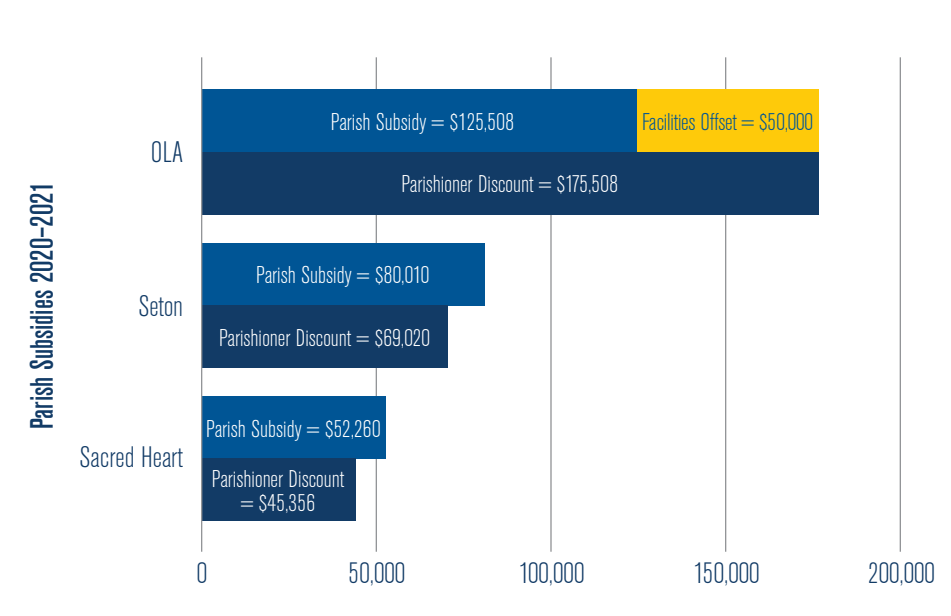

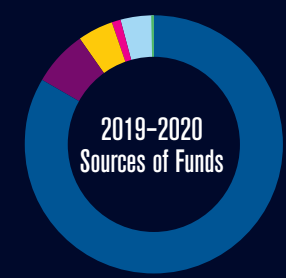


Purchased required equipment for the 2020-2021 school year

- Additional iPads and Chromebooks to provide 1:1 devices for each student
- Temperature scanners and hand sanitizer dispensers
- Personal protective equipment (PPE) for staff and students to use as needed
- Stanchions and floor decals to support proper social distancing
- Walkie-talkies for staff to maintain communication
- Storage container for furniture removed from classrooms to meet social distancing requirements
- Carts for teachers to allow mobility as they change classrooms rather than the students changing classrooms
- Classroom podiums in place of teacher desks to meet social distancing requirements
- Schoology, an online platform that supports transition to eLearning if needed

- \$453,000 of tuition assistance provided; a 42% increase from last year
- Obtained a loan/grant through the Paycheck Protection Program of the Small Business Administration to ensure all staff continued to be paid in full
- Implemented eLearning within three days of the campus closing
- Hosted a virtual day of fun for students to offset the loss of school activities
- Prayed the Rosary daily via Zoom during the month of May
- Sacred Heart Parish offered weekly school Mass via livestream during quarantine
- Held the 8th grade Awards Ceremony via Zoom and celebrated their graduation with a special livestreamed Mass
- St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish hosted the end of year school Mass
- Our Lady of Angels Parish supported improvements and repairs to the HVAC system and social distancing painting on the blacktop
- Fall 2020 At-Home Learning option for families unable to or uncomfortable with returning to in person classes

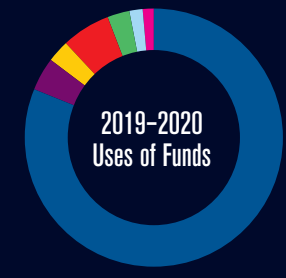
Thank you to our three parishes, Our Lady of Angels Parish, Sacred Heart Parish, and St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish, for providing subsidies that offset the parishioner discount. The 2020-2021 tuition rates are \$6,934 for parishioners; \$7,920 for non-parishioners; and \$8,052 for non-Catholics.
