2022 Annual Appeal





Dear Families and Friends of Aguinas,

The new school year is off to an exciting start: not just "finally back to normal," but "better than ever before"! Along with forming students in faith in our new atrium and in reason with new hands-on science materials, we have a surge of volunteerism and new initiatives from our newly restructured and newly elected PTO and an inspired cadre of new teachers bringing new life to the school. It is the Year of Hope in our virtue program, in which we focus on growing in trust in God's loving plan. Coinciding with the National Eucharistic Revival and the Diocese of Arlington Eucharistic year of preparation for the 50th anniversary of the diocese, our school theme is Adoro Te Devote (Humbly, I adore You),

the hymn written by St. Thomas Aquinas to Jesus in the Eucharist. Along with singing a verse of this hymn each Thursday morning during school announcements, we are excited to improve our worship in song at school Masses, singing classic hymns supported by the organ, praise music with piano accompaniment after Communion, and learning a polyphony Mass setting to sing the parts of the Mass. It is a beautiful year at Aquinas! Our enrollment is up, and we ask your support in rebuilding our enrollment by letting your family, friends, and fellow parishioners know what a treasure we have in Aquinas and what a blessing it could be for their children.

Thank you for your strong support of last year's Annual Appeal, which provided us with funds toward facilities repairs. This year, I ask that you consider supporting Tuition Assistance through a gift to our Annual Appeal. A couple years ago, the Aquinas Advisory Council collaborated to redesign the tuition structure for the school, making tuition match our cost-per-student. At the same time, our three supporting parishes made a lasting commitment to provide financial support for each of their parishioners attending Aquinas, to offset the parishioner discount offered by the school. In spite of the effects of the pandemic upon enrollment, adjustments to staffing have kept our budget balanced and our tuition plan on schedule. This allows me the opportunity to ask your help in supporting families in need of financial assistance, to make an Aquinas education accessible for every family who desires our mission for their children.

This year, about one-third of our families are receiving tuition assistance, after applying and qualifying through FACTS Grant and Aid, a third-party evaluation of financial need. About \$495,000 in assistance has been awarded to families this year. We receive strong support from the diocese to make this possible. The diocesan Scholarship Foundation (funded by the Virginia Tax Credit Program) provides about \$165,000 to our students. Diocesan grants and scholarships provide another \$120,000. Several Aquinas benefactors sponsor annual scholarships, totaling about \$23,000. The remaining \$187,000 is built into our budget, to be funded by Aquinas. My request to you this year is to help us offset this amount, to keep Aquinas accessible to




